

Commercialization procedure for capacities made available on the market by GDF SUEZ at the Fos-Cavaou LNG terminal

In accordance with the European Commission's decision of 3 December 2009 accepting the commitments proposed by GDF SUEZ (*), GDF SUEZ is informing the market of the commercialization procedure for regasification capacities made available on the market as from 1 January 2011 at the Fos-Cavaou LNG terminal, entering in France's South Zone ("Commercialization procedure for capacities at the Fos-Cavaou LNG terminal").

GDF SUEZ is taking this opportunity to invite all companies that are considering booking the capacities proposed by GDF SUEZ at the Fos-Cavaou LNG terminal to attend an informational meeting on the manner in which those capacities will be commercialized.

The *Commission de régulation de l'énergie* (the French Energy Regulatory Commission) (CRE), the body charged with monitoring in regard to the above commitments, and the *Société du terminal méthanier de Fos-Cavaou* (STMFC) have also been invited to attend this meeting.
