
# Corporate ESG Rating Certificate for ENGIE

ENGIE has solicited us to conduct an independent ESG and sustainability rating

As of December 2022, ENGIE obtains an A1 rating, based on an overall score of 70/100. ENGIE ranks within the top 2% of all companies rated by MESG worldwide (4,866 in total) and seventh within the Electric and Gas Utilities sector. The company's overall score has increased by 2 points since our 2021 review, displaying Robust to Advanced performance for all the sustainability criteria under review.

Impacts: While the Group's carbon footprint is considered intense, its carbon intensity factor demonstrates a continuous decrease since 2015. Significant investments in renewable energy and a total phasing out of coal by 2027 should allow for further reduction. Social KPIs (health and safety, diversity, and training) reveal mixed trends.

**Risks:** ENGIE's risk management system appears comprehensive, covering its most material ESG risks. The group displays an Advanced capacity to safeguard and enhance all its strategic assets: reputation, human capital cohesion, operational efficiency and legal security.

Management: ENGIE appears to proactively integrate ESG factors into its governance, strategy and operations. Its approach is supported by quantified targets and a broad level of stakeholder involvement. Comprehensive measures and processes address the most material challenges. ENGIE keeps facing eight controversies, including four of high severity. The company communicates transparently on all but one of the cases, and has implemented corrective measures in relation to two of them.

This issuer-solicited corporate ESG rating was produced using research about ENGIE from our database as well as interviews with 4 directors, one Board member and one employee representative from ENGIE, conducted between October 24<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> and on November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Our 20 pages assessment report was delivered on 19/12/2022, covering 6 domains and 25 sustainability drivers. It is structured around 3 key pillars:

- 1. The social and environmental impacts of ENGIE's products and services, its strategy for the future, and its ability to invest in and create sustainable value;
- 2. ENGIE's capacity to identify and mitigate its ESG risks and to preserve and increase the value of its strategic assets (including reputation, human capital, operational efficiency and legal security);
- 3. The strategic and operational integration of social responsibility topics in ENGIE's governance, operations and reporting, including the balance and dynamics of stakeholder relationships.

Our analysis aims to inform investors, asset managers and other relevant stakeholders of the nature, weighting and level of integration of ESG factors by ENGIE, as well as its ability to identify and mitigate related risks.

ENGIE is a French company involved in the generation and sale of power from thermal, nuclear and renewable sources. It operates natural gas transportation, storage and distribution networks and facilities, and provides energy services for local authorities, individual and professional customers. In 2021, ENGIE and Crédit Agricole Assurances acquired a 97.33% stake of Eolia Renovables. In 2022, the group completed its sales of Equans to Bouygues, and Endel to Altrad Group.
